




A BILL

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

Councilmembers Kwame R. Brown, Harry Thomas, Tommy Wells and Carol Schwartz introduced the following bill, which was referred to the Committee on

To rename a portion of South Capitol Street, S.E., to Taxation Without Representation Street, S.E.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as "Taxation Without Representation Street Renaming Act of 2008."

Sec. 2. Pursuant to section 401 of the Street and Alley Closing Acquisition Procedures Act of 1982, effective March 10, 1983 (D.C. Law 4-201; DC Official Code § 9-204.01), the Council of the District of Columbia designates the portion of South Capitol Street, S.E. that intersects with N Street, S.E. and Potomac Avenue, S.E. as "Taxation Without Representation Street, S.E."

Sec. 3. Fiscal impact statement.

1 The Council adopts the fiscal impact statement in the committee report as the fiscal
2 impact statement required by section 602(c)(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act,
3 approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02 (c)(3)).

4 Sec. 4. Transmittal.

5 The Secretary to the Council shall transmit a copy of this act, upon its effective date to
6 Director of the Department of Transportation.

7 Sec. 5. Effective date.

8 This act shall take effect following approval by the Mayor (or in the event of veto by the
9 Mayor, action by the Council to override the veto), a 30-day period of Congressional review as
10 provided in section 602(c)(1) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December
11 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 813; D.C. Official Code § 1-206.02 (c)(1)), and publication in the District of
12 Columbia Register.
