

A PROPOSED RESOLUTION

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to amend the Old Morgan School Place Designation Act of 2005 to change a segment of Old Morgan School place N.W. back to its original name of Champlain Street N.W.

BE IT ENACTED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this act may be cited as the “Old Morgan School Place NW Renaming Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2010”.

Sec. 2. (a) There exists an immediate need to change the name of a segment of Old Morgan School Place NW back to its original name of Champlain Street NW.

(b) With the reopening of Champlain Street NW under the Marie Reed School, Champlain Street has been reconnected with a segment of roadway that was renamed to Old Morgan School Place creating a situation that is confusing to motorists and emergency responders.

(c) It is important to create a more rational street naming scheme at the time that residents and visitors are acclimating to this new street pattern.

(d) As maps are updated to reflect the new street pattern, it will be most efficient maps can be simultaneously updated with the new street names.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia determines that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it

1 necessary that the Old Morgan School Place NW Renaming Emergency Act of 2010 be  
2 adopted after a single reading.

3           Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
